
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. Talk about how when thunder rumbles, it makes the Rr sound.
  Rumble, rumble. Point to words in the book with the Rr sound.
- More Difficult: Sometimes two letters are combined to make one sound, such as sh, th, ch. These are called digraphs. As you read the story, listen for the digraphs th, sh, and ch. Make a list of those words.
- Challenging: There are four main stages in the water cycle: evaporation, condensation, precipitation and collection. Which stage is taking place during a drought?
