- Visit your library and find more facts about goats. Add them to your list.


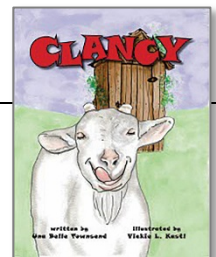
