



## J and P

In the boxes above, find all the J's and color them.

Next, find all the P's. Color them.

A capital **J** sometimes gets a "hat". But we put it on last. We do the same with a lowercase **j**. It has a tail like a kitty cat. We start on the middle line and curve below the bottom line. Then we pick up our pencil and give it a dot for a "hat"!





To make a capital **P**, start on the top line and go straight down. Pick up your pencil. Go back to the top and put on the curve.

Lowercase **p** begins on the middle line and goes down past the bottom line. Pick up your pencil. Now add the circle or curve.
