
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



• Easiest: Read the story together. Point out the upper case and the lower case Wws as you read. Example: with, woods, wait

 More Difficult: Cause and effect is a relationship between events in the story. Things happen (cause) that make other things happen (effect). For example,

What caused Elmer to bounce up and down?
What caused the workers to think Bigfoot had been at the work site?

What caused the workers to jump in their truck and leave?

 Challenging: A root is the basic word part from which other words can grow.

Example: sleep + ing = sleeping

What are the roots in these words? doing, asked, shoes
