



Use rolled up playdough “snakes” to make several 5 inch pieces and 3 inch pieces. Then on a clean surface, follow the strokes above to make a capital **T** and a lowercase **t**. If you don’t have playdough, pieces of yarn or string will work, too.

**Below:** Color the boxes with an uppercase or lowercase **T t**. Or, roll up balls of playdough, and place one on each box with a **T t**. Don’t have playdough, use small objects like coins.
