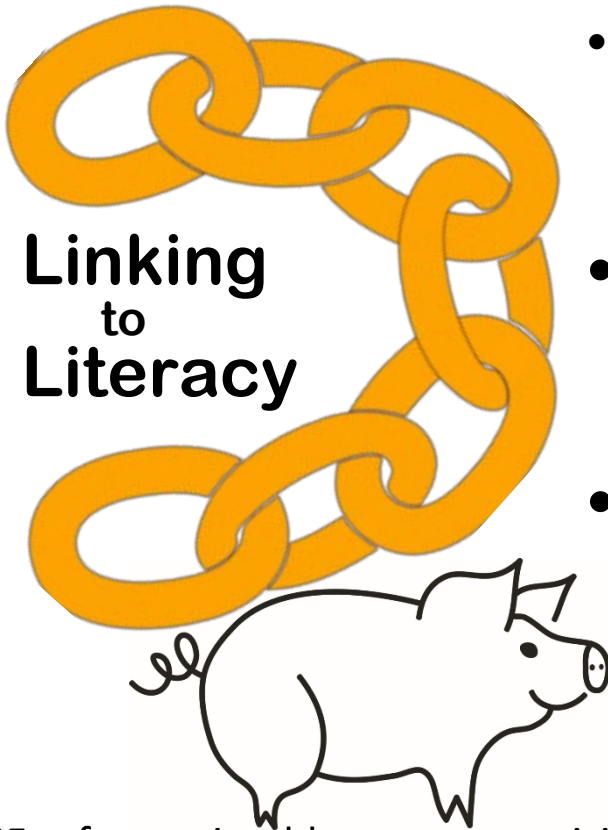


Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:

Linking to Literacy



- **Easiest:** Read the story together. **Pp** makes the sound you hear at the beginning of **pot** and **pig**. Can you find other words in the book that have the letter **Pp**?
- **More Difficult:** When two words are used together to make one word, we call it a **compound word**. Example—pot + belly = potbelly. Can you think of a few more **compound words**?
- **Challenging:** We **capitalize the beginning of a sentence, days of the week, months, proper names, and holidays**. Find **capital letters** in the story and tell the reason why each one has been capitalized.
