
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. Before each page turn, predict what will happen next in the story.
- More Difficult: Locate the letters Uu on the front cover. Talk about the sound they make.
 Listen for, and locate, the upper and lower case
 Uu as you read the story together again.
- Challenging: A, E, I, O, U, and sometimes Y, are vowels. The remaining letters are consonants. Using a deck of alphabet cards*, separate the cards into two piles—Vowels, and Consonants.
