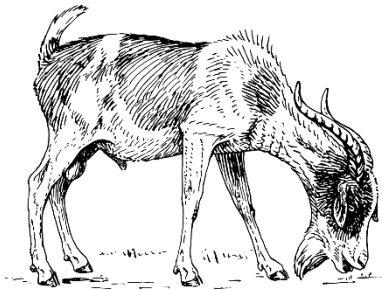


Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:

Linking to Literacy



- **Easiest:** Read the story together. On each page, help your child **locate capital** and **lowercase Rr**. Say those words out loud to reinforce the **sound Rr** makes.
- **More Difficult:** An **antonym** is a word of **opposite** meaning. **Example: hard/soft**
Find several antonyms in the story.
- **Challenging:** This story is **set** in Mongolia. The **main character**, Dash, has school at home. She does not go to a school building. How is her “school” different than yours? How is it alike?
Compare the two types of schools.
