
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together then sing the alphabet song. Next, place alphabet cards* in alphabetical order, using the song for hints.
- More Difficult: Find these words* in the book and talk about their meaning--cat, fur, kitten, paws, nose, eye, mouth, tail
- Challenging: Assist your child in researching "cat" on your computer or at the library. Next, have them list three or more facts* about cats.
