
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



• Easiest: Read the story together. Watch for, and point out, words that name a person, place, thing. These are called nouns.

Examples: birds, bees, antlers, house

- More Difficult: Words that describe an action, like run or jump, is an action verb.
 Work together to find action verbs in the story.
- Challenging: In the story, did Alfred give up and quit? No. Name two things he did that show he kept trying.
