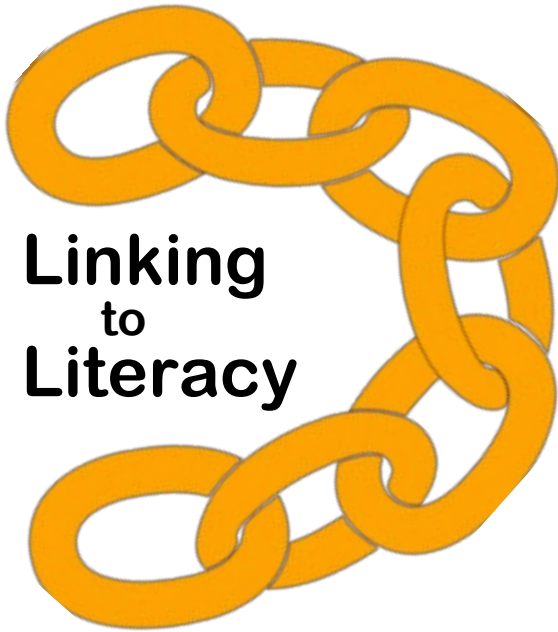


Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- **Easiest:** Read the story together. Watch for, and point out, **words that name a person, place, thing**. These are called **nouns**.
Examples: birds, bees, antlers, house
- **More Difficult:** Words that **describe an action**, like run or jump, is an **action verb**. Work together to find action verbs in the story.
- **Challenging:** In the story, did Alfred give up and quit? No. Name two things he did that show he kept trying.
