
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story. If you find a word you are not familiar with, write it down. Then look it up in a dictionary, or Google it!
- More Difficult: Words are made up of syllables, each having one vowel sound. Find several words in chapter one that have two, three, or four syllables. A printable activity sheet is available at the website below.
- Challenging: Verbs can be active or passive. Find several active verbs where the subject is doing the action. Then find several passive, or being verbs, where the action is being done to the subject, or by someone (or thing) else.
