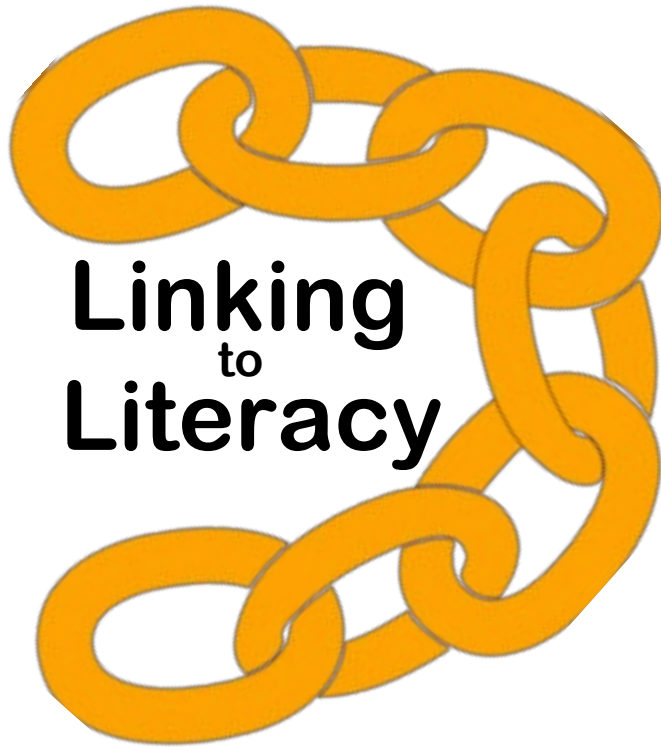


Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- **Easiest:** Read the story together. Watch for clues and predict what will happen on the next page.
- **More Difficult:** Sentences begin with a capital letter and end with a period, question mark or exclamation mark. Select a page and count how many sentences are on that page.
- **Challenging:** Kip forgot he had a map. Draw a map of where you live and your street. Add a compass rose and mark the directions—north, south, east, west.
