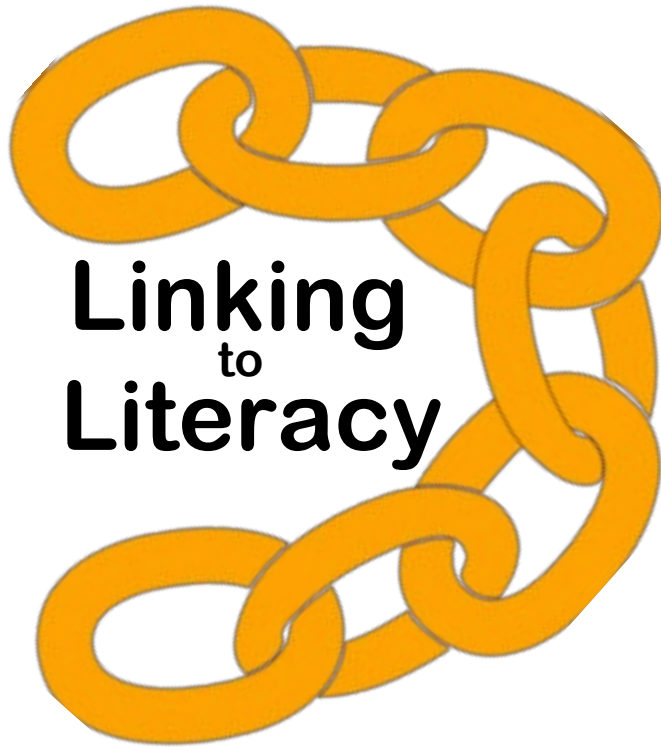


Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- **Easiest:** Read the story together. Point out the capital **T**'s in the title, **A Truck Named Tony**. Read the story again to find capital **T**'s as well as discover lowercase **t**'s.
- **More Difficult:** Notice the punctuation, or “stop signs” at the end of each sentence. Decide if it is a question mark, period, or exclamation mark.
- **Challenging:** Verbs are words that show action. On each page, locate and list action verbs.
