

Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. Point out the capital G and the lowercase g. Listen to the sound it makes. How many upper and lowercase g's can you find?
- More Difficult: Rhyming words have the same (or similar) sounds at the end (example—bat, cat), even though it may be spelled differently (example—they, hay) How many rhyming pairs can you find in the book?
